

Pistol Range Standard Operating Procedure (SOP)

PURPOSE

- Provide a safe place to shoot pistols at up to 75 yards.

CONTACTS

- Club officers listed at the front gate or club house door

SAFETY/RULES

- No shooting at steel targets closer than 25 yards, and shoot at steel targets head on to prevent ricochets.
- No use of any ammunition that damages steel targets.
- Use of exploding and organic (vegetable/fruit etc.) targets **including ALL incendiary tracer rounds is strictly prohibited**.
- Use of 50 BMG, Full Auto or Simulated Full Auto, Bird Shot, or Clay Pigeon Throwers is **strictly prohibited**.
- Must use steel targets or paper targets on back board. Glass, plastic, exploding or organic targets are prohibited.
- All targets must be placed at berms.
- You bring, you remove it and take it home. (targets/trash/etc)
- If multiple users, everyone shoots from 25 yard line, unless agreed upon by all users. All users must shoot from same distance.
- No reserving range unless through club meeting and sanctioned event.
- Must listen to, and abide by, on-site club officers or designated club Range Safety officer (RSO)
- When safety allows, spent shell casings must be picked up.
- NO RIFLE CALIBERS, FULL AUTO or SIMULATED FULL AUTO!
- Pistol caliber carbines are allowed.
- Please do not move the benches or tables.
- Any damage to targets or range needs to be reported to a club officer.
- Shotguns may only be used at designated area to left of targets. First come first served for patterning a shotgun, but must be considerate to tying up range during peak hours.

USE OF THE RANGE IS A PRIVLEDGE. VIOLATION OF THE RULES COULD RESULT IN THE LOSS OF THE USE OF THE RANGE, OR LOSS OF MEMBERSHIP

MAINTENANCE

- Grass cutting, brush removal
- Rock removal from berm
- Targets, including steel and backer boards
- Trash
- Overhead shelter maintenance
- Bench maintenance
